"PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP AWARDS" PROGRAM

Purpose

The American Road & Transportation Builders Association "Public-Private Partnership (P3) Awards" program is an annual competition to honor and draw attention to individuals, companies and public agencies that demonstrate outstanding achievement in the establishment and delivery of U.S. transportation P3 projects.

Award Categories

The "P3 Awards" competition is structured into two categories — "P3 Champion of the Year" and "P3 Project of the Year."

P3 Champion of the Year: This award is given to an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to the forward progress of P3s in the U.S. transportation industry.

P3 Project of the Year: This award spotlights a project that demonstrates the economic or innovation values P3s bring to the U.S. transportation construction industry. All firms and/or agencies that played a significant role in the nominated project should be cited in the application. The award itself is given to the entire project team. Winners may purchase additional awards for project partners if they so desire.

Eligibility

Anyone may nominate one project and/or one candidate for each available award. Self-nominations are encouraged.

A P3 project is defined as a contractual agreement between a public entity and private entity that transfers the responsibility of a project's engineering, construction, operation and/or maintenance to the private sector for a defined period of time.

For "P3 Champion of the Year," the nominated individual must meet the following requirements:

- The contributions made must have directly impacted the U.S. transportation marketplace.

For "P3 Project of the Year," a project must meet the following basic requirements:

- The project must be a P3 transportation project based in the U.S.
- The project must be fully-operational at the date of entry.
- The project team must have been selected through a competitive process.

Evaluation Criteria

The following criteria will be used to judge nominations.

P3 Champion of the Year

- Contribution to the forward progress of P3s.
- Promotion of innovative practices or ideas.
- Improve and/or publicize the economic benefits of P3s to the public.

Project of the Year

- Innovation in procurement, financing or delivery.
- Increased quality and/or efficiency when compared to a traditional procurement model.
- Cost savings/value for money.
- Meeting or exceeding project milestones.
- Demonstrated economic benefit to the public.

Submission Information

All applications must be submitted online and include the following information:

- Complete online form
- At least two photographs showing significant features of the project (no more than five photographs). Each photo should include information indicating the entry name, description of the view shown and photo credits (credits are optional). All other graphics must include the name of the nominated project or organization and description of the information provided by the graphic.
- Contact information for local and regional media outlets to be contacted in the event the entry is selected as a winner.

There is no application fee for nominations. All materials become the property of the ARTBA and may be used for appropriate purposes. Nominations will not be returned.

Nomination Deadline

Nomination forms must be received by ARTBA by **close of business June 4.**

Selection Process

An independent Selection Committee consisting of select ARTBA members will judge the submissions.

Awards Notification

Winning entries will be notified on or before July 1. All applicants will be notified of the results of the Selection Committee.

Awards Presentation

Winners will be recognized during the 2018 ARTBA P3 Conference held in Washington, D.C. July 18-20.
